
KEYBOARD NUMBER CHART



On an 88-key piano or keyboard, the lowest note is A1, and the numbers increase with each successive A



- Play every A on your keyboard, ascending, and descending. Make a mental note that A is between the 2nd and 3rd of the 3-black key group. Notice that all A's have a similar sound. Do the same with every B, C, D, E, F, and G making note of the location and sound of each key. Begin and end your practice sessions with this exercise until you know the location of all the keys.
- o Play and sing every A B C on your keyboard, then every F G A, D E F, and G A B
- o What is the highest key on your keyboard? (letter and number) Answer: _____
